The project is developed in five countries-UK-England, Greece, Romania, Slovenia and Spain and lasts for two years. The institution which initiated the project was University of Gloucestershire, Cheltenham, UK. Partners in this project are: University of Thessaly-Greece, Platon M.E.P.E., Katerini- Greece, "Gheorghe Titeica" Elementary School Craiova-Romania, Solski Centre Kranj, Kranj-Slovenia, Furness Academies Trust, Barrow-in-Furness-UK, Institut de Vilafant, Vilafant-Spain, Working with Europe-Spain.



The iCAP project gathered partners from across Europe in Vilafant, Catalonia from March 22nd to March 23rd, 2018 to share the experience gained in the project.

In the first stage, the participants presented the activities they have carried out so far within the local community they are part of. Innovation was the main theme, with each country setting up and running different activities. It has been noted that each participant has specifically managed the activities. Spain, for example, involved three compact classes in the activities , while Romania shose two pupils in each class to participate in the project.



This stage of this meeting laid the foundation for more serious results, namely the transposition of the results gathered in the local community into real daily life. The challenge is to find those activities and methods that will guarantee the spread of iCAP ideas among all people. Thus, for the next 6 months, project participants have proposed to implement innovation in reality by taking advantage of the resources available in each country.
